### Special Report from Elsie and Danny, Directors of DPM-India



Dear Friends, Supporters and Prayer Partners,

Greetings to you in the precious name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We are excited to share with you a summary of the outreaches we did in the month of April:

#### Siliguri (West Bengal, India) Pastors Meeting

On 10<sup>th</sup> of April, we were in the city of Siliguri in West Bengal. Although a small city, it is a very strategic place, being surrounded by eight Indian states and four countries. The Bangladesh border is barely 16 kilometres from here; the Nepal border 37 kms; Bhutan is 60 kms away and just 135 kms to China. The Christian population

here has a majority of Nepali-speaking churches, so we went into Siliguri armed with copies of the Nepali *Life Changing Spiritual Power* and *Power of Proclamation*. 40 Pastors from Siliguri gathered at the Church of North India's Diocesan hall. We did a brief teaching on *Divine Exchange* as we had only a short evening meeting with these Pastors, basically to introduce Derek Prince Ministries to them. **They were blessed by the teaching and literally grabbed all the books they could get. We had also taken other titles in Hindi and English books.**



#### Sikkim (N.E. India between Bhutan and Nepal): Pastors/Leaders Seminar

On 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> of April, 46 Pastors/leaders from different churches gathered at the Bethesda Church in Lower Gangtok (main city) under the leadership of Rev. L. B. Rai, one of the senior Pastors in this city who had previously been a senior official in the Government of Sikkim. **On request, we taught on the subjects of *Divine Exchange*, *Spiritual Warfare* & *Power of Proclamation*.**

**They were very happy to receive the notes that we have prepared for our Derek Prince Bible College Curriculum. What amazed me was the thirst and the sincerity with which they attended the sessions.**

The organiser had announced that the sessions would start at 9.30 a.m. and every one of the pastors was present at 9.30 a.m. sharp. Quite an unusual thing to see in India! And they stayed through until 5 p.m. without any signs of tiring at all!

The state of Sikkim is predominantly a Buddhist stronghold. So at the end of the two-day seminar we joined together in warfare over the powers of darkness in the spiritual realm, ending finally with a declaration that the Word of God would break through the strongholds of Buddhism and release people into the knowledge of the true and living Saviour, Jesus. As we prayed and warfared it grew dark and rain and hail poured from the skies. But we knew that we had overcome in the spiritual realm and the devil was not happy with that.

At the end of the first day, Rev. Rai went back home and the Lord seemed to have opened up his heart to the ministry of DPM. So he came back to us the next day and requested that we come back to do a similar seminar in Kalimpong, another city on the way to Sikkim, and then go with him over the border into Bhutan to do a seminar with Pastors there. Of course we cannot do open meetings in Bhutan, but the kind of teaching that we do without attracting much publicity or advertisement is just the kind of ministry that is needed there. **So God willing, we have another appointment to keep later this year to minister to more Pastors in that region in the Buddhist nation of Bhutan. It is really amazing to see the way God opens the doors before us. We go without knowing who we are meeting or what kind of people they are, but God works amazingly in every place and we are left humbled by His awesomeness.**



#### **Madurai (Tamil Nadu, South India) Book Distribution:**

Our church youth team was scheduled and go to Madurai on 29th April to do some songs, dances and skits at a youth meeting. A village missionary movement that has 210 workers in 210 different villages in the Madurai - Virudhunagar region was organising a massive youth rally in Madurai where youth from all their mission areas were going to be brought together. **They were expecting around 20,000 youth in the age group of 18 to 30 to attend.**

The main focus of this meeting was to challenge the youth to commit to ministry and they were expecting 2,000 such commitments. We felt that we should provide each one of those young adults committing themselves to the Lord's ministry with a copy of the *Life Changing Spiritual Power* compilation book in Tamil. We went to the organisers to see if they would allow that, and needless to say they were more than grateful to receive such a blessing for their ministry workers. **So on Monday we went to the meeting in Madurai where no less than 25,000 people - in the age group of 20 and above - were gathered in a huge tent. Our boys did their part and at the end of the meeting the LCSP books were distributed to about 1,800 who committed to join hands with the missionary movement in ministering in the villages. We also provided each of the 210 village missionaries with a copy of the book.**



**We praise the Lord for all He has done and for the thousands of people who now have a compilation of six of Derek's powerful books.**
