

Women Leadership Seminar - Tamu, Myanmar (Burma)

We had an adventurous journey taking two and a half days. We travelled 423 miles from Yangon to Monywa on good roads, then 216 miles from Monywa to Kalaymyo on very poor roads meaning we could only travel between 15-20 mph. The last leg of the journey was 86 miles on smooth roads from Kalay to Tamu.



When we arrived we expecting about 50-60 to attend the meetings, but when the seminar started more and more people kept arriving until over 200 people attended. Some of the participants had travelled for five days, some on foot, some by boat and some traveled by trucks all leaving their homes and families and work to come and hear the Word of God.

It was one of the greatest and most anticipated seminars ever been held in the area. Jacob, the DPM Myanmar Director taught on the Christian leadership and Ethics during which we handed out the book *Does Your Tongue Need Healing?*

Sandar taught on the topic of Biblical and Spiritual Healthcare which is much needed and important subject for all in this area of Myanmar. Many of the people who attended only have a basic knowledge of health care education. So Sandar took the advantage to teach on personal health care and cleanliness in the home and environment.

It was a great joy for us seeing women eager to listen and learn by taking the opportunity to come and listen to the teaching we brought. The purpose was to grow and build them up spiritually, physically and ethically. So that they would be pass that knowledge on and educate others in their own areas.

We brought 70 copies each of the three books of Derek Prince, *Does Your Tongue Need Healing?* *Transformed For Life* and

Objective for Living. Everyone who attended received a copy of one of the books, but because so many people attended we had to ask them to share the books with each other.



Because of the lack of dental care in the area Sandar did not only teach on the subject but also held a clinic and over the three days she saw 56 patients. Most of them needed teeth extracted to remove infected teeth and prevent decay to those remaining.

We thank God for the opportunities He provides for us to teach and provide practical care. The Lord truly blessed the participants through our teachings and the Derek Prince books we distributed. We would like to thank you so much for your prayers and support throughout these three days.
